URPP Language and Space of the University of Zurich is pleased to announce the *Workshop on Accommodation in Speech Communication*. The workshop, bringing together researchers working in the areas of phonetics and speech sciences, multimodality, interaction analysis, linguistics, psychology and computer sciences, aims to provide a forum for discussing corpora, methods and measures, currently applied in accommodation research to quantify convergence in speech communication.

As the phenomenon of accommodation occurs at several linguistic and extra-linguistic levels, and its dynamics may vary noticeably depending on speaker-specific, linguistic and situational factors, topics for which contributors are invited include:

- Acoustic/articulatory measures of convergence in interactive and non-interactive speech tasks
- Multimodal synchronization in face-to-face interactions
- Lexical, grammatical, syntactic and conversational alignment in speech communication
- Indexical, linguistic and contextual factors affecting degree and direction of accommodation
- Code-mixing/switching in language contact situations

Given that accommodation is not a prerequisite of human-to-human speech interactions, we also encourage the submission of proposals dealing with:

- Accommodation in written interactions
- Accommodation in animal communication
- Human-to-machine, machine-to-human accommodation
